In 1997, she established The Children's Ear Clinic in Sydney with Patricia Janssen and Jon Gamble, offering an alternative to multiple courses of antibiotics and surgery for children with chronic ear infections. A special interest of Nyema's is acute health care. She uses homeopathic medicines as a first line of treatment to help patients avoid medications with harmful side effects. Nyema was President of the Australian Homeopathic Association NSW branch from 2000 – 2003, Executive Officer of the Australian Register of Homeopaths (AROH) 2003 - 2005. She has been a speaker at the 2007 and 2009 Mindd Forums.

## **ABOUT THE SEMINAR**

Even with the best possible diet and health care, all children get sick. For ASD children, it is vital to avoid antibiotics and other pharmaceutical medications.
